Our safety program consists of policies and procedures that follow the Occupational Health & Safety Act and Regulations for Construction Projects as well as for Industrial Establishments.

We stay up to date with all applicable legislative requirements and ensure that everyone from the worker to management follows their health & safety responsibilities.



A few areas of our program we wish to share:

NEW HIRES & TRAINING

All operators are required to attend the College of Trades – Hoisting Engineer program and complete with good standing.

New hires go through Northern's extensive In-House Training Program to ensure they understand proper rigging and hoisting techniques, driving skills as well as review the company's health and safety program policies and procedures to obtain the proper knowledge to perform their jobs safety and effectively.

Through guidance with senior operators and upper management helps our new workers excel.

WORKPLACE & EQUIPMENT INSPECTIONS

Northern's Safety Department conducts regular workplace inspections and evaluates the workers' equipment inspections to determine they are done properly and prior to operating any piece of equipment.

Everyone in the company has the responsibility to perform Pre-Trip Inspections on the piece of equipment they are about to operate, this includes company trucks, cranes, Boom trucks, and yard equipment.

Hazard Assessments are also conducted to ensure that the work they are about to perform is going to be done safely and effectively to the best of their knowledge and expertise.

MAINTENANCE

Our maintenance program highlights the importance of proper maintenance as it is a vital part of a safety program.

In addition to ensuring that workers use the tools and equipment properly, it is vital that tools and equipment be inspected, maintained, and kept in good repair. Our maintenance program reduces the risk of injury, damage, and lost production.

We follow the guidelines of Schedule 1 and its legislation and retain all records with every piece of equipment.
